

## Request Book Design

When requesting a quote estimate for your book project please try to answer the following questions:

1. How many pages is your manuscript? OR What is the word count of your entire manuscript?
2. What do you visualize the size of your book to be? (Example sizes: 6 x 9, 8 x 11, 5.5 x 8.5, 9 x 12)
3. Do you have images that need to be illustrated?  
-OR-
4. Do you have photos that need to be scanned?
5. Do you have any charts, tables, graphics, diagrams, etc? How many do you have and have they been typeset, designed and scanned into your computer?
6. Have you thought of a title page, table of contents, index, bibliography, glossary and/or footnotes?
7. Have you thought of an authors page and dedication page? These are nice to add to give your book a personalized feeling.
8. Have you visualized the design of your book? It could be simple or complex.
9. Think about what you visualize the cover of your book to be. It is the first thing the buyer will be attracted to.
10. Do you have a few chapters of your book ready to send? This helps with the quoting development.

Please do not worry about having all of the answers to the questions above. This is just preliminary to get you thinking about the process.
